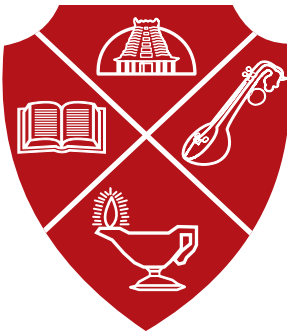

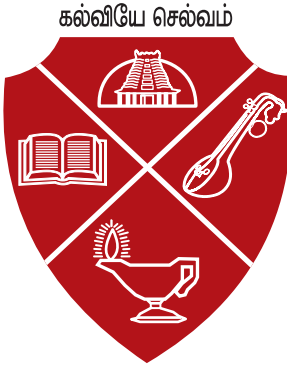

SECTION I

GENERAL

HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

Thiru. Karumuttu Thiagaraja Chettiar is the founder of the College.

Thiagarajar College of Preceptors, Madurai is run by Manickavasagam Charitable Foundation. The college is affiliated to the Tamilnadu Teachers Education University, Chennai for the B.Ed., degree course. The sanctioned strength at present is 100 in aided section and 100 as additional intake section.

It is situated in the eastern part of Madurai and on the western side of Mariamman Teppakkulam. Inter-related activities are facilitated with the proximity of Thiagarajar Model Higher Secondary School, Thiagarajar College, Sri Meenakshi Sundareswarar Girl's Higher Secondary School and Sourashtra Girl's Higher Secondary School are the other Educational Institutions situated in the neighbourhood.

The College was declared open on 29th June 1956.

COLLEGE COUNCIL

The College Council consists of the Principal (Ex - Officio President) and all the staff members. The council elect its own secretary every year. The functions of the council except where otherwise specified are advisory.

COURSE OF THE STUDY

B.Ed., COURSE

The optional subjects offered under methodology are Tamil, English, Mathematics, Physical Science, Biological Science, History and Commerce.

Our College got the recognition from NCTE and affiliated to Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, Chennai for an additional intake of 100. Affiliation is granted for the optional subjects namely English, Mathematics, Physical Science, Bio-Science, Commerce and Computer Science.

SECTION II

COLLEGE REGULATIONS

ADMISSION

A Degree holder of any recognized University can apply for admission to the B.Ed., Course. Post Graduation is a must for commerce candidates. Admission is made by single window counselling system. Admission of graduates from universities other than the Tamilnadu Teachers Education University is subject to the approval of the syndicate of the Tamilnadu Teachers Education University.

PERIOD OF TRAINING

The period of training will normally last for Two academic years. At the end of the year, students have to appear for the B.Ed. Degree Examination of **Tamilnadu Teachers Education University**.

PROBATION

Every student admitted shall be considered to be on probation for fifty working days and if it appears to the Principal that any of the student is not likely to prove as an efficient teacher, such a student shall be required to leave the institution.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The following scholarships will be awarded to the eligible students :

1. Scholarship for Physically Handicapped students.
2. Scholarship for Ex - Service personnel.
3. Government Scholarship to SC and ST students.
4. State Government Scholarship to BC and MBC / DNC students.

RAILWAY CONCESSIONS

Journey concession form will be made available to the students for going home for recognised vacations and returning from home at the end of the vacations and for other purpose, like educational tours, excursions etc, sponsored by the college. Students can also avail railway concession tickets. Students are not eligible to apply for the concessions during other holidays on their own.

DISCIPLINARY RULES

The rules of discipline shall include the following :

1. Every student shall wear a respectable dress.
2. Every student shall wish the Principal and other members of the staff on the occasion of his first meeting for the day within the college precincts.
3. If a member of the staff enters the classroom, the students should rise and remain standing till they are directed to sit or till the teacher takes his seat.
4. No student shall be allowed to leave the classroom without permission or until after the teacher has left the room.
5. Every student should be in the College precincts before 9.20 A.M. Late comers have to sign in a separate register. The late coming will be viewed seriously by the authority.
6. Prayer will be conducted from 9.30 a.m. to 9.45 a.m. everyday by the students subject wise.
7. Students shall assemble in their respective classrooms in the forenoon after the prayer, and in the afternoon soon after the first bell is ring. Students shall not congregate or loiter in any part of the corridor during the instructional hours.
8. Students moving from one class to another shall do so in an orderly manner and with as little noise as possible.
9. Students are forbidden to displace or misplace in any way with the furniture of the college. Any damage done to them will be recovered from the entire body of the students.
10. Students shall not engage themselves in any political or communal movements. Severe disciplinary action will be taken against those who in any way disturb the atmosphere and tradition of the college. The students should observe the dictum **“To learn obeying is the fundamental art of governing”**.
11. Switch-off Cell Phones while in Class rooms.

ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE

Students will be very carefully watched by the anti-ragging committee members. Women students will be ensured with safety. If any misbehaviour is noticed among students, first they will be severely warned. If the same behaviour continues, memo will be issued to them and suitable punishment to the extent of suspension and dismissal will be given.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

Grievance redressal cell is functioning in our college to redress the grievance of students. They can approach the concerned staff to set right their problems.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE

1. All applications for leave with details regarding the period and the cause should be submitted to the principal in the prescribed form at least a day before it is required.
2. (i) Leave may be granted amounting to not more than seven days at a time exclusive of Sunday and other holidays.
(ii) When leave is applied for owing to sickness the production of a certificate by a registered Medical practitioner may be required.
3. (i) Students are not permitted to absent themselves without previous notice to the Principal /Concerned Staff.
(ii) In case where absence without leave is unavoidable, applications for leave must be submitted as soon as possible and in no case later than the first day of return to the college.
(iii) Absence without leave for a part of the day will be treated as absence for full day.
4. The necessary attendance certificate will not be granted unless the Principal is satisfied that the student's progress and conduct have been satisfactory.

5. In case of shortage of attendance, applications for condonation must be made to the University authorities and unless such condonation is obtained students may not be able to take the examination.

OBSERVATION AND PRACTICE TEACHING

In view of the intensive teaching practice and observation envisaged by the University and N.C.T.E., Students will be apprenticed as teachers in several schools in the neighbourhood in addition to Thiagarajar Model Higher Secondary School.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Physical Education and Games form an integral part of B.Ed. Training. Attendance for to be these classes is compulsory. Physical education and yoga form a regular part of the B.Ed. curriculum.

EDUCATIONAL TOURS AND VISITS

The educational possibilities of instructional tours and visits are being increasingly recognised whenever such excursions are organised by the college. It is obligatory on the part of the students to participate in such events and add to the richness of their training at the college. On all such occasions they shall remember that they carry the good name and honour of the college in their hands.

SECTION III

OTHER ASPECTS OF COLLEGE ORGANISATION

LIBRARY AND READING ROOM

The library is a growing sector with nearly 16,500 volumes of books at present. Facilitate easy location and quick reference. The computerised and automated library system of our college.

LIBRARY RULES

1. The library is in the immediate charge of the librarian.
2. All the students and members of the staff of the college are members of the college library.
3. The library will remain open from 8.45 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. on all working days.

4. Strict silence and decorum should be maintained in the library.
5.
 - a) Every student will be entitled to borrow two books at a time.
 - b) The Principal may at his discretion direct to issue any student additional books for a specified period if he is satisfied that the student has shown a marked capacity for using the books.
6. During the library hours, open access is permitted to the students. Students are strictly instructed not to disturb the arrangement of books on shelves while searching for the books. If any student is found abusing the privilege given and unnecessarily disturbing the arrangement, he will forfeit the privilege of borrowing books.
7. Students are expected to use all books with care. On receiving a book from the counter a student shall examine it at once and call the librarian's attention if any damages found on it. If he fails to do so he will be held responsible for any damage that may be afterwards detected.
8. Students are prohibited from passing on books to another and from lending them to person not connected with college.
9. Books should be returned on or before the last date stamped on the return slips in the books. If that date however happens to be a holiday the next working day will be considered as the date on which the books are due. Books taken out or used during vacations should be returned not later than the fifth working day from the date of the reopening of the college. It shall however be within the discretion of the librarian to recall at any time any book or books lent to a student irrespective of the time limit prescribed above.
10. A student absent from the college on the due date will not be considered as a valid reason for failure to return book on that date.
11. A student failing to return a book within the prescribed time will be fined one rupee for each working day and the default library fine shall be paid to the librarian. Books will not be issued to those who are in arrear in respect of their library fines.
12. A book may after being returned be taken again for a second time with a special approval of the librarian provided there is no other applicant for it.

13. The principal may make such arrangement as he may deem desirable for the issue and return of books during the holidays.
14. The books issued from the library shall be returned in time otherwise a student ceases to be a member of the library. No collegiate certificate and conduct certificate will be granted to a student who does not return all the books issued to him.
15. If a book is damaged or lost that book has to be replaced by the person who is held responsible.
16. Only current journals will be placed on the reading table.
17. Books of reference and journals should not be taken out of the library.
18. The Library rules must be strictly followed or student will forfeit the privilege of borrowing books.

COLLEGE UNION

The Associations of all the teachers trainees are known under the general name of “College Union”

There are also Sectional Associations for different subjects. The Principal and the concerned subject teachers are the Presidents and Vice-Presidents of the college union and sectional Associations respectively.

The Professors in the other subjects are the vice-presidents of the sectional association concerned. A subject secretary and a joint secretary are elected by the union and for each of the sectional associations. The election shall be conducted in a peaceful, orderly and decorous manner. The president’s decisions are final with regard to the affairs of the College Union and the Sectional Associations.

All the students of the college are members of the Union. The objectives of the sectional associations shall be to study and discuss educational subjects and those of professional and general interest. Members of the staff and old students of the college are welcome to attend and to participate in the meeting convened by the union and shall abide by the decision of the President and Vice President of the sectional associations.

COLLEGE MAGAZINE

The College Magazine will be published once in a year. It will be a record of various activities of the college during the academic year and will contain articles by the teachers and students.
