Sub: Thiagarajar College of Preceptors, Madurai District - Continuation of Conditional Provisional affiliation to offer B.Ed. (Additional Intake) Degree course from the academic year 2012-2013 - Granted - Orders issued - Regarding.

- From Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, Chennai first affiliation order No.TNTEU/R/Affln/B.Ed(AI)/2009-2010/655, dated 15.09.2009.

I am, by direction, to inform you that the Syndicate of the University, at its meeting held on 10.10.2012 has considered the request of Thiagarajar College of Preceptors, Madurai District together with the report of the inspection commission and compliance report submitted by the college and granted Continuation of Provisional affiliation to Thiagarajar College of Preceptors, Madurai District (College Code: 11221) to offer B.Ed. (Additional Intake) Degree Course from the academic year 2012-2013.

In accordance with the above orders, the order of continuation of provisional affiliation is issued now to the college from the academic year 2012-2013.

The conditions laid down by this University for affiliation are furnished below which the College should strictly adhere to and any lapse will attract penal action under the provision of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University Act.

The Following Conditions shall be strictly adhered to.

- 1. All the conditions laid down by the NCTE, Bangalore.
- 2. Candidates to be admitted in B.Ed. Degree course should (a) satisfy the eligibility conditions prescribed in the Regulations and the guidelines to be prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu for the academic year 2012-2013 (b) obtain approval from the University for the students admitted to B.Ed. degree course as per prescribed norms (c) earn required attendance prescribed by the University for appearing for the University Examinations.
- The admission of students for B.Ed. Degree Course shall be made in accordance with the guidelines for admission to be prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu for the academic year 2012-2013.
- 4. The Syllabus prescribed by the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University shall be followed. (Copy enclosed)
- The college shall complete the working days prescribed by the University in the Regulations prescribed for B.Ed. course in an academic year.
- Arrangement shall be made by the college for the conduct of University Examinations.
- No donations shall be collected from the students seeking admission to any course of study in the college.
- The Management of College shall not discontinue any existing course without prior permission from the University which should be intimated before the 30th September of the respective academic year.
- The college shall only collect Tuition and other fees from the students at the rates as prescribed by the State Government / University.
- The College should have [1] Separate lounge [2] Rest room [3] Toilet for Women Faculty.
- 11. A Librarian, Physical Director/Directress and a Medical officer with the prescribed qualification shall be appointed.
- 12. Number of teaching and non-teaching staff shall be appointed as per norms prescribed by the University/ U.G.C./NCTE/Government for each course.
- 13. No teacher shall be appointed, if he/ she has not fulfilled the qualifications as laid down by the University and U.G.C./NCTE from time to time.
- 14. An agreement shall be entered into with each teacher to be appointed as per the requirements of the University/ Tamil Nadu Private Colleges (Regulation). Act and rules there under.
- 15. The College shall implement each and every one of the recommendations of the Inspection commission.

- 16. The classrooms shall be according to the suggested U.G.C./NCTE norms.
- 17. The library should be strengthened, as suggested by the Inspection commission. The library shall have common reading room and stack room as per standard prescribed by the U.G.C. /NCTE/ Government.
- 18.The teacher should be paid as per pay scales of UGC/AICTE/NCTE/VI pay commission of the State Government, as the case may be, and their salary should be paid through Banks, by means of Cheques. This will be verified by the authorities from time to time.
- The maximum number of students who may be admitted to each of the course shall not exceed the strength sanctioned by the University/NCTE.
- 20. Laboratory shall be strengthened, as suggested by the Commission. The Laboratory shall have sufficient equipments required for performing experiments prescribed for the courses of study. The laboratories shall also have adequate arrangement for gas supply, regular water supply and electricity. The safety standard shall be fully observed.
- 21. Necessary Hostel accommodation, Staff quarters, Play ground are to be provided.
- 22. The posts of teacher and Head of the Departments wherever required for the proposed course shall be filled up before starting the course.
- 23. No teacher shall be appointed or shall be continued in service, who has attained the age of superannuation as may be prescribed by the Tamil Nadu Government.
- Suitable leave rules for teaching and Non-teaching staff be framed, generally in conformity with the State Government rules.
- 25. Approval shall be obtained from the University before appointing the teaching staff.
- 26. Such other Rules and Regulations as may be generally prescribed from time to time by the University shall also be complied with.
- 27. If all the conditions of Provisional affiliation granted are not complied with by the end of the period fixed then affiliation or approval shall cease automatically.
- The College should obtain planning permission and Building Permit from the competent authorities for constructions.
- 29. As per the "National Council for Teacher Education, (Recognition Norms and Procedures Amendment)" Regulations 2010 an institution shall be permitted to apply for new course of M.Ed. and B.Ed. additional intake after it has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), with at least Letter Grade B developed by NAAC.

The Management shall submit the document at Sl. No. 30 within a month from the date of receipt of this order.

 Documentary evidence for payment of Infrastructure and amenity charges as per Tamil Nadu Gazette Notification regarding Levy of Infrastructure and Amenities Charges Rules 2008, vide notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated 26.01.2008. The Management shall submit the documents required under Sl.Nos. 31 & 32 on or before 30.04.2013.

- Certificate under Section 37(B) of Tamil Nadu Land Reforms (Land fixation and Ceiling) Act, 1961, vide notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated 10.06.2010.
- 32. Land Area, whether Wet or Dry Land (Wet Land Conversion Certificate issued by Directorate of Town and Country Planning in case if it is Wet Land as per the new Section 47(A) in the Tamil Nadu Town and Country Planning Act 1971, vide notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated 01.01.2011.

While communicating the above decision, I am to request you to kindly forward a specific and detailed report in this regard, immediately after fulfilling all the above conditions of affiliation.

The Management has to apply for continuation of provisional affiliation from the academic year 2015-2016 for which the Management shall submit the prescribed application on or before 31.10.2014 along with the processing fee prescribed by the University. The Management of the College shall renew the Continuation of Provisional affiliation until Permanent Affiliation is granted.

It is further informed that, after completion of 5 years of affiliation and with accreditation by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) 'B' Level Certificate, a college may apply for permanent affiliation in the prescribed format with prescribed fees. Conditions prescribed by the University for Grant of permanent affiliation have already been communicated in this office letter No. TNTEU/R/Affln./Syn.Oct.10-Item23,25/2010/1898 dated 08.12.2010 and the same is published in the university website (www.tnteu.in) also.
